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FOUNDER'S LETTER

If there is one word that defines 2025 for Soul Bilingue, it is SHINE!

It was a year in which our cause gained even more visibility, reached new spaces, and mobilized an ever-growing community of people who believe in the same idea that has driven us from the beginning: the world is bigger than my neighborhood!

Throughout this year, we saw young people gaining confidence to speak English, taking on new challenges, broadening horizons, and discovering possibilities that once seemed distant. We saw volunteers donating time, knowledge, and affection. We saw partners walking alongside us and strengthening a movement that goes far beyond teaching a language. After all, for us, English is a bridge to achieving much greater things (and sometimes unimaginable ones).

Speaking English means opening doors, creating connections, expanding repertoires, and transforming the future. I am convinced that when a person allows themselves to access something new, they begin to see paths they could not imagine before. And when that happens, their trajectory changes forever.

Year after year, we keep proving that solidity, impact, and expansion do not happen by chance. They are built with hard work, dedication, courage to experiment, humility to learn from mistakes, and willingness to continuously evolve.

We arrive in 2026 more mature, more prepared, and deeply proud of the journey we have built so far.

Seven years of dedication to a mission that continues to be guided by the same values that gave rise to Soul: we believe that knowledge is freedom, that representation transforms, that evolving is the game, and that speaking another language means breaking down barriers.

Here, we are building a community that wants to dialogue with the world without losing its essence. Players who carry their stories, their roots, and their Brazilian identity with pride, while discovering that they belong anywhere they choose to be.

Looking ahead to 2026, we continue to dream big.

We want to expand our reach, strengthen our community, create new international opportunities, and continue connecting young people to experiences that broaden their worldview and their confidence to build their own future. We know there are still many barriers to be broken down. But we also know there is an entire community willing to create new paths (and spaces) with us.

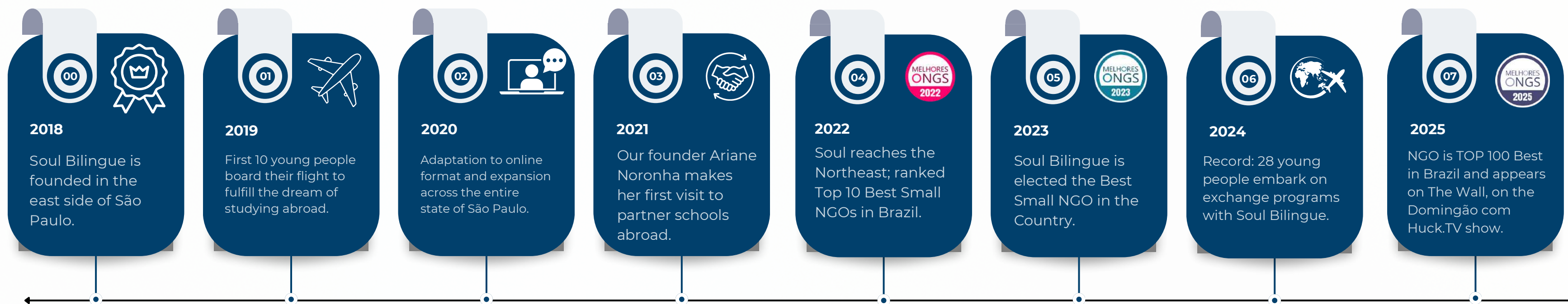

Soul Bilingue believes that having a second language and living an international experience broadens one's worldview. Therefore, it advocates for a bilingual and globally connected nation. This advocacy primarily addresses the social mobility of people in situations of economic vulnerability – neither English nor access to the world is a challenge for those who have money. In the **Game Soul** program, every approved young person goes through a 22-week online learning methodology with weekly classes, emotional support, individual mentoring, access to information, and much more. At the end, the ranking identifies the winners of English language scholarships, with accommodation included, abroad.

In January 2025, Ariane Noronha and Will Almeida represented Soul Bilingue on The Wall segment of the Domingao com Huck TV show. The appearance brought our mission of democratizing English and exchange programs to millions of Brazilians.



Throughout the show, we shared the story of Soul Bilingue and the impact generated in the lives of low-income youth. The moment amplified the organization's national visibility and strengthened the credibility of our cause.



With an emotional victory, we won R\$324,709 to invest in strengthening the NGO, expanding our service capacity and our investments in technology and social impact.

Being part of this selection again is a source of great pride and a demonstration of the strength of our community, the trust of our partners, and the collective commitment to transforming lives through education.

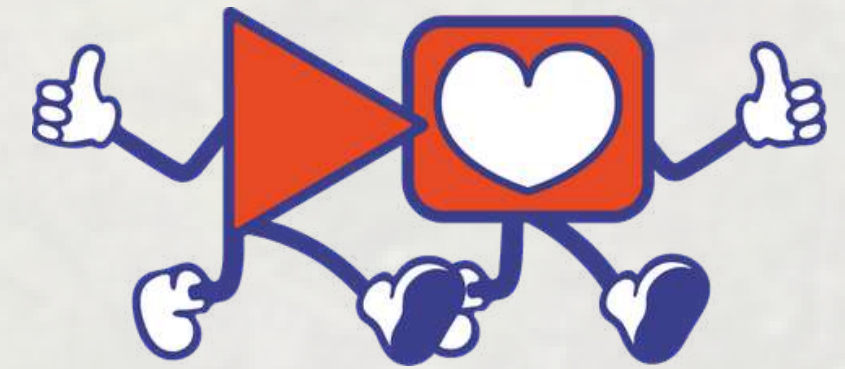

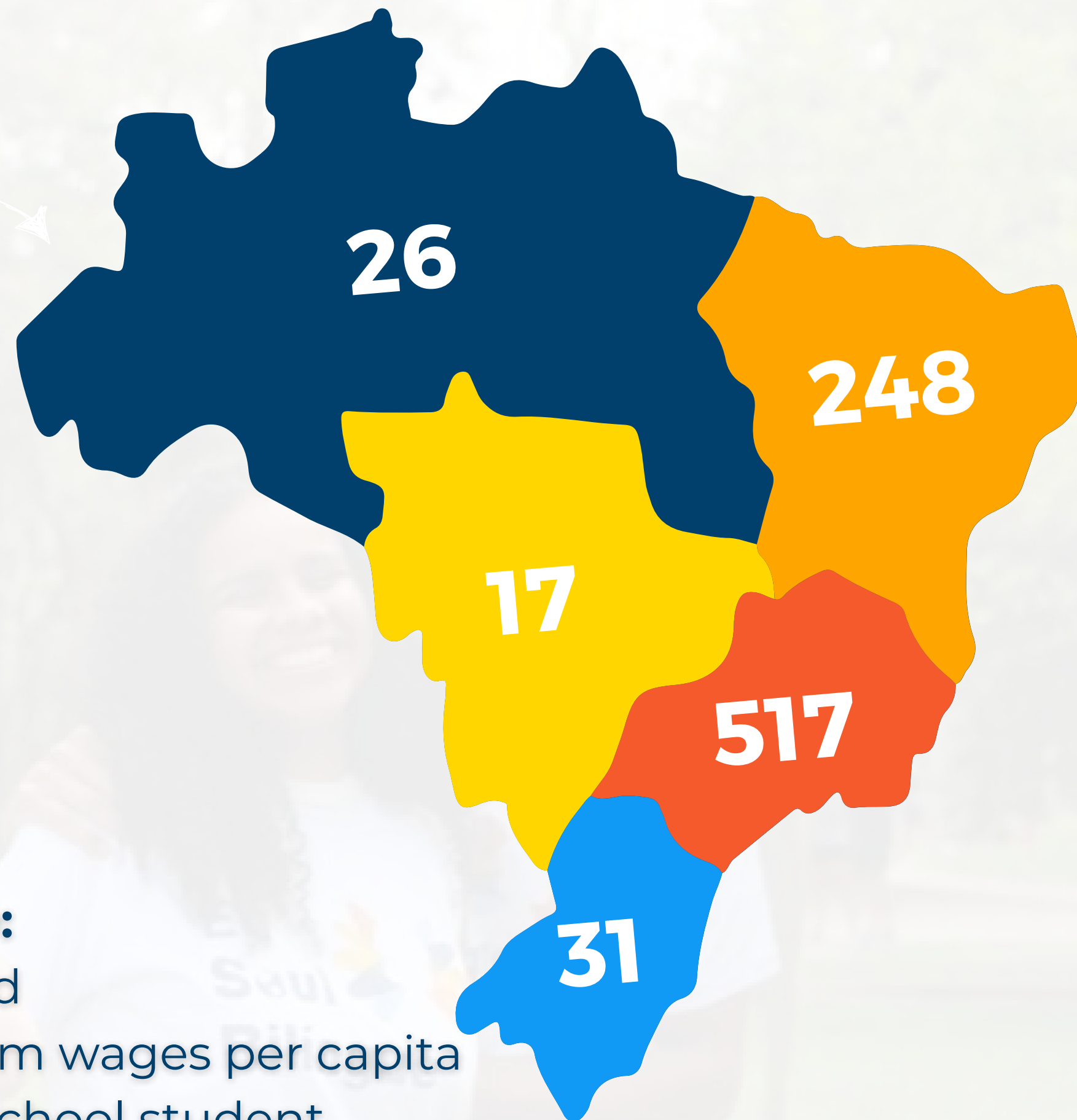

Lasting 22 weeks, the Soul Bilingue Game changes the life perspective of young people from public schools with a gamified methodology that combines learning English as a second language, offering exchange scholarships abroad to the highest-ranked students, and various communication challenges, among other activities. In 2025, for the first time, it reached the entire country, expanding into the South and Midwest.

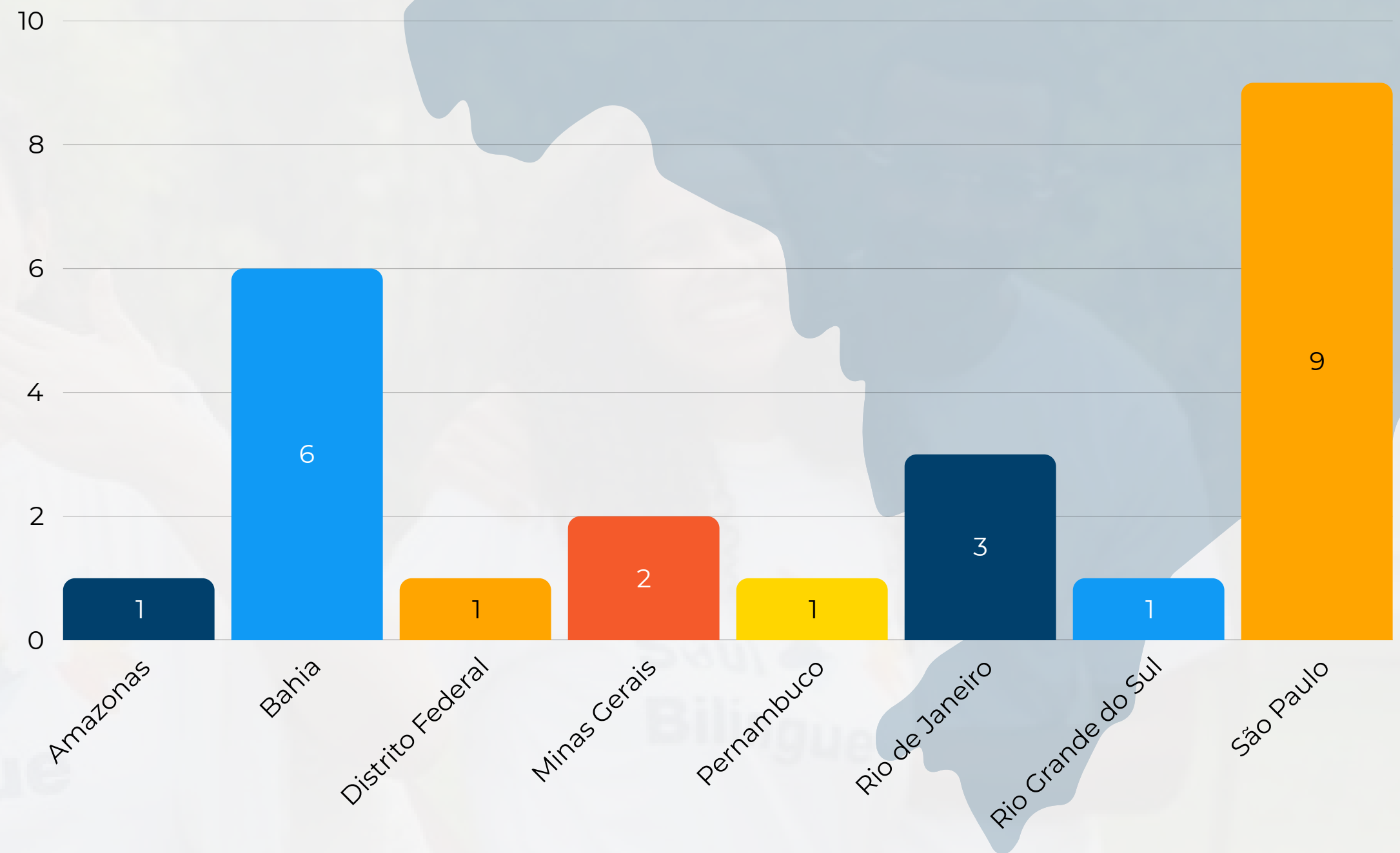

New ambassadors

Young Ambassador is the title given to students who complete the Game Soul in the top positions of the ranking and, as a result, earn the exchange scholarships that the social organization secures with partner schools in various countries. In 2025, 24 people achieved the long-awaited international exchange. The map shows that despite representing 58% of the total new exchange students, the Brazilian Southeast is beginning to share space with all other regions, which now have at least one representative in the NGO's first year of nationwide service, aligning with the goal of decentralizing international experience opportunities among Brazilians.

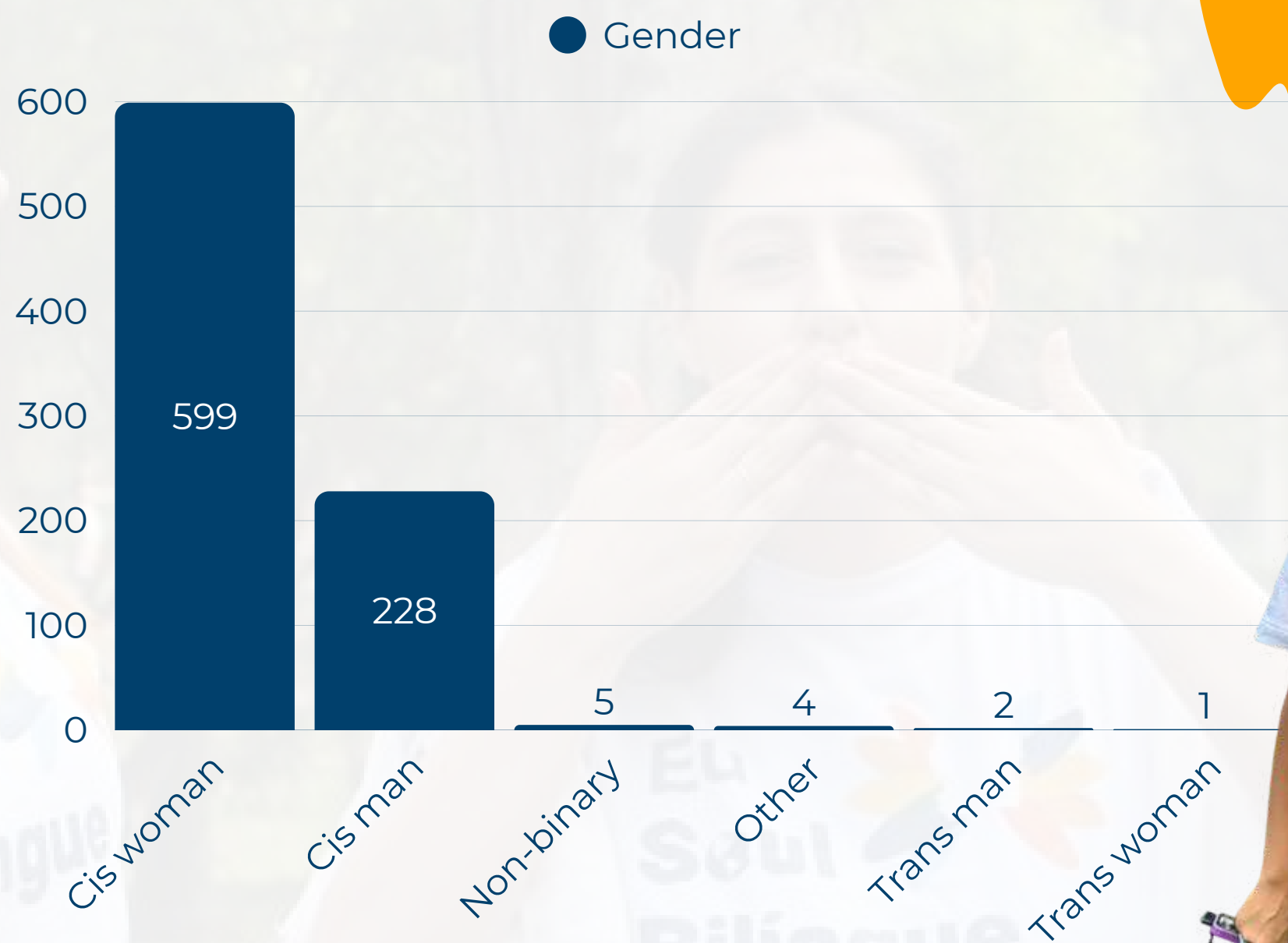


Young ambassadors in all regions of Brazil

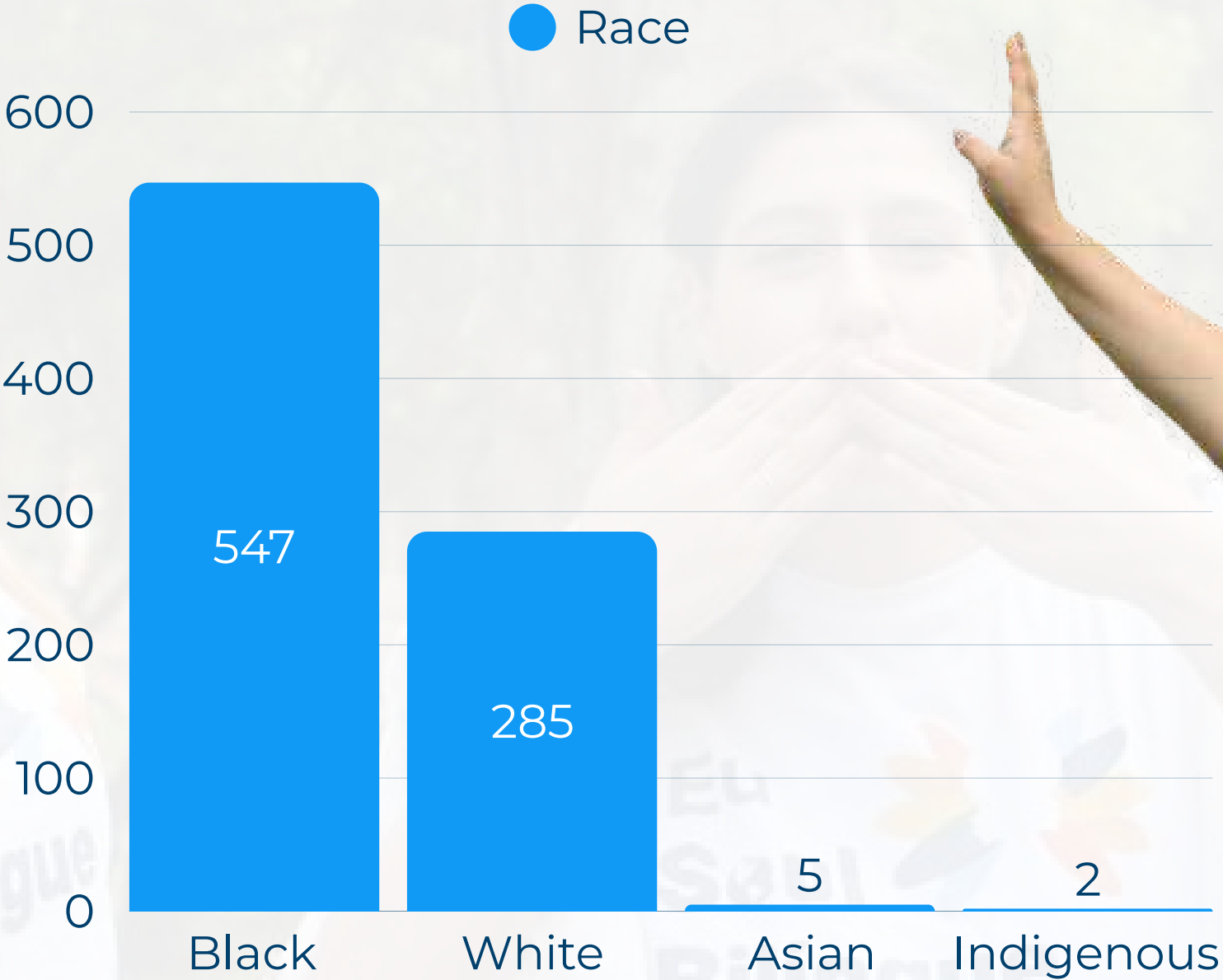

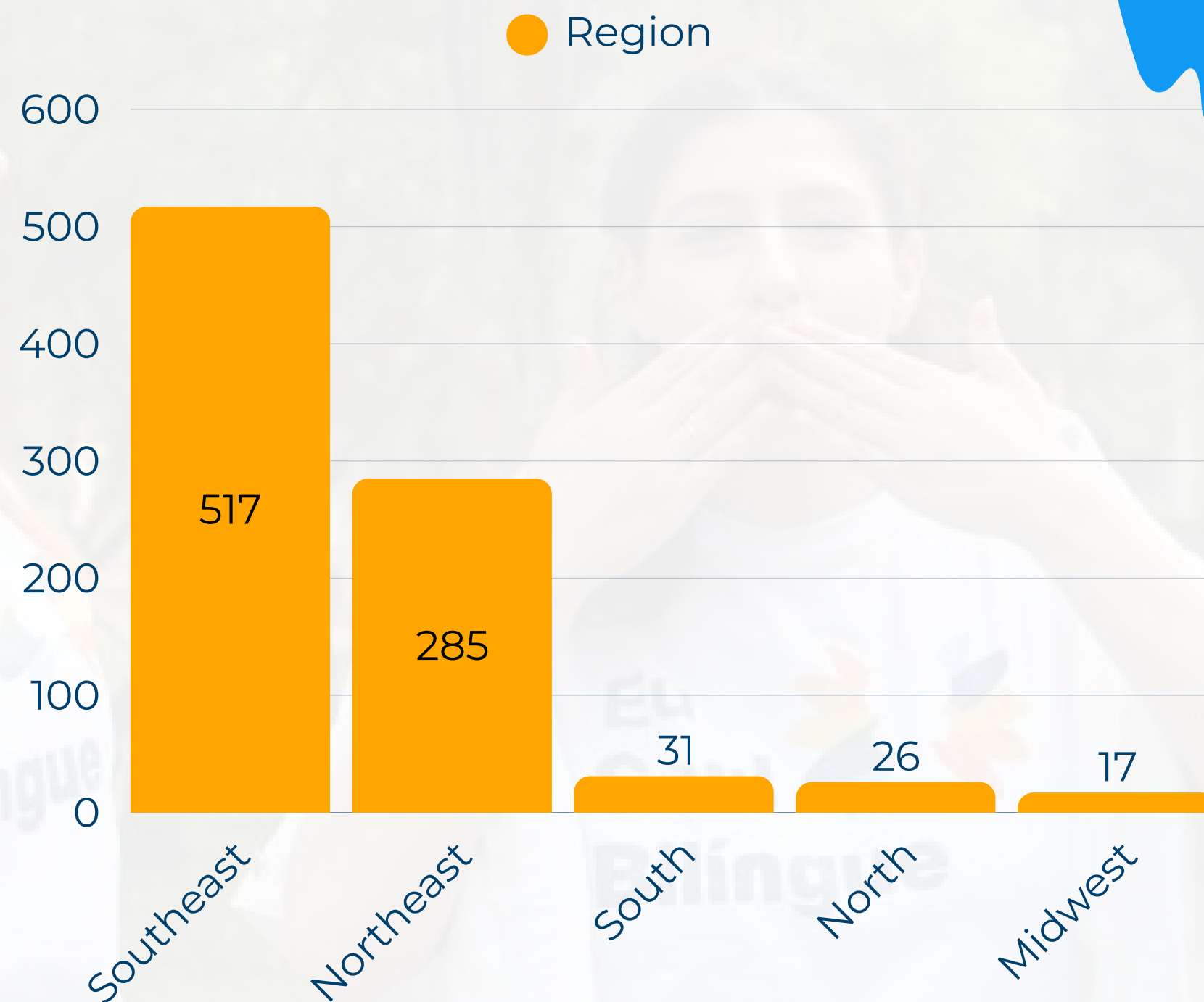

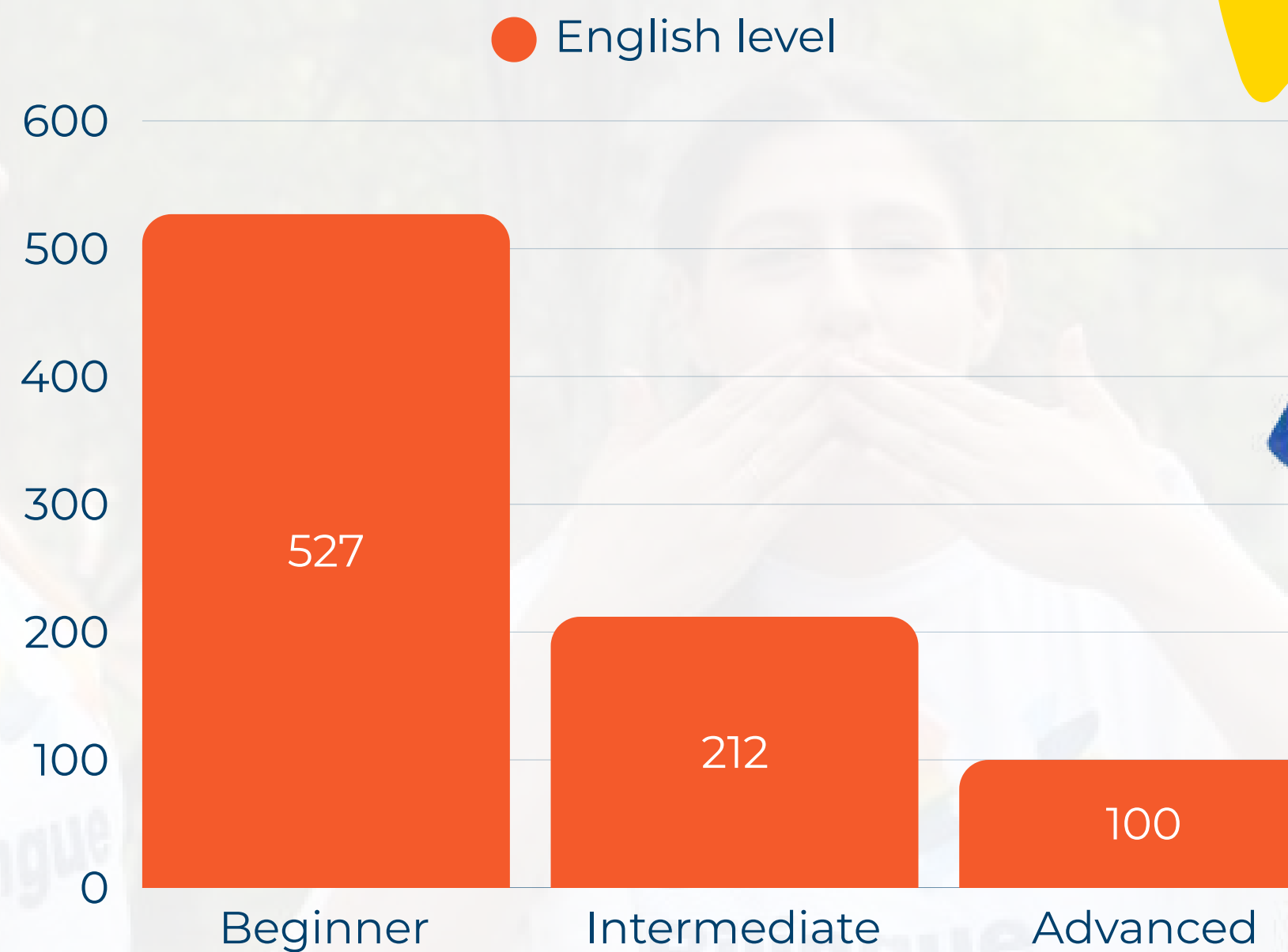

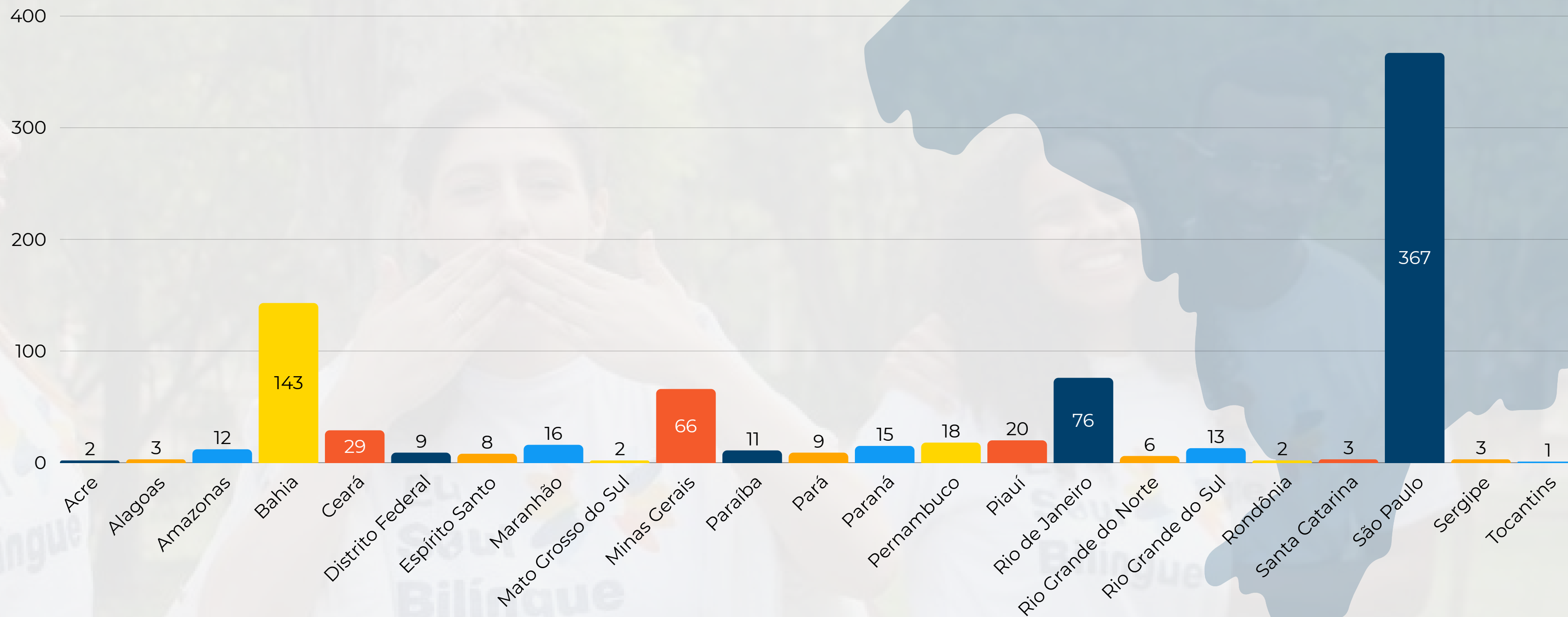

Enrollments by state



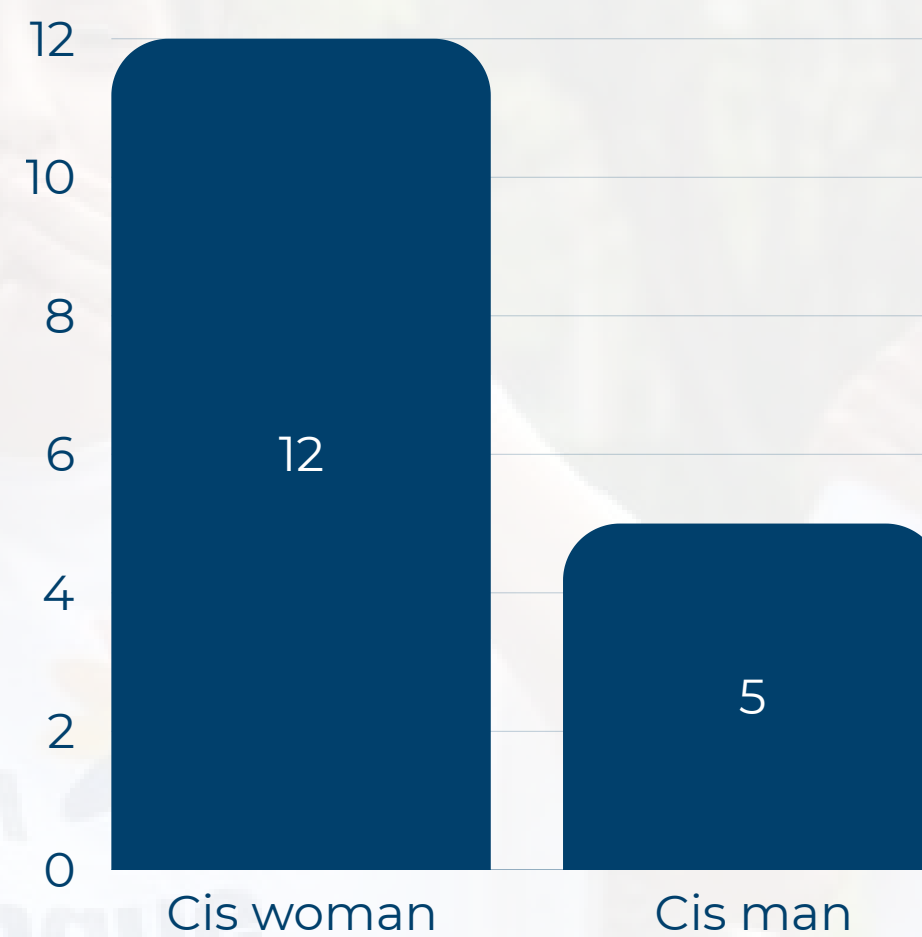

With fixed themes and biweekly group meetings, the psychologists, or *counselors*, as they are called at Soul Bilingue, work to help students gain more awareness about mental health and develop self-esteem, confidence, and a better understanding of their frustrations.

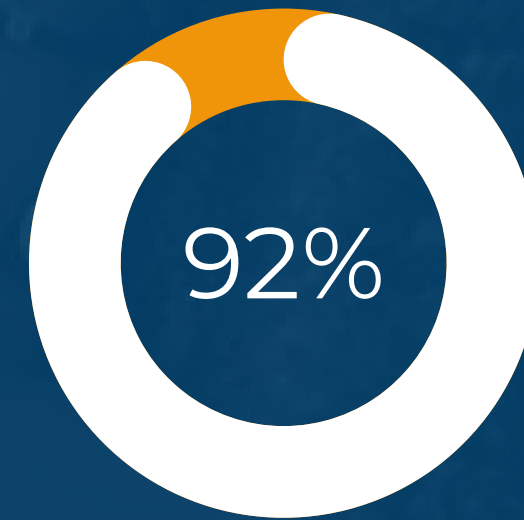

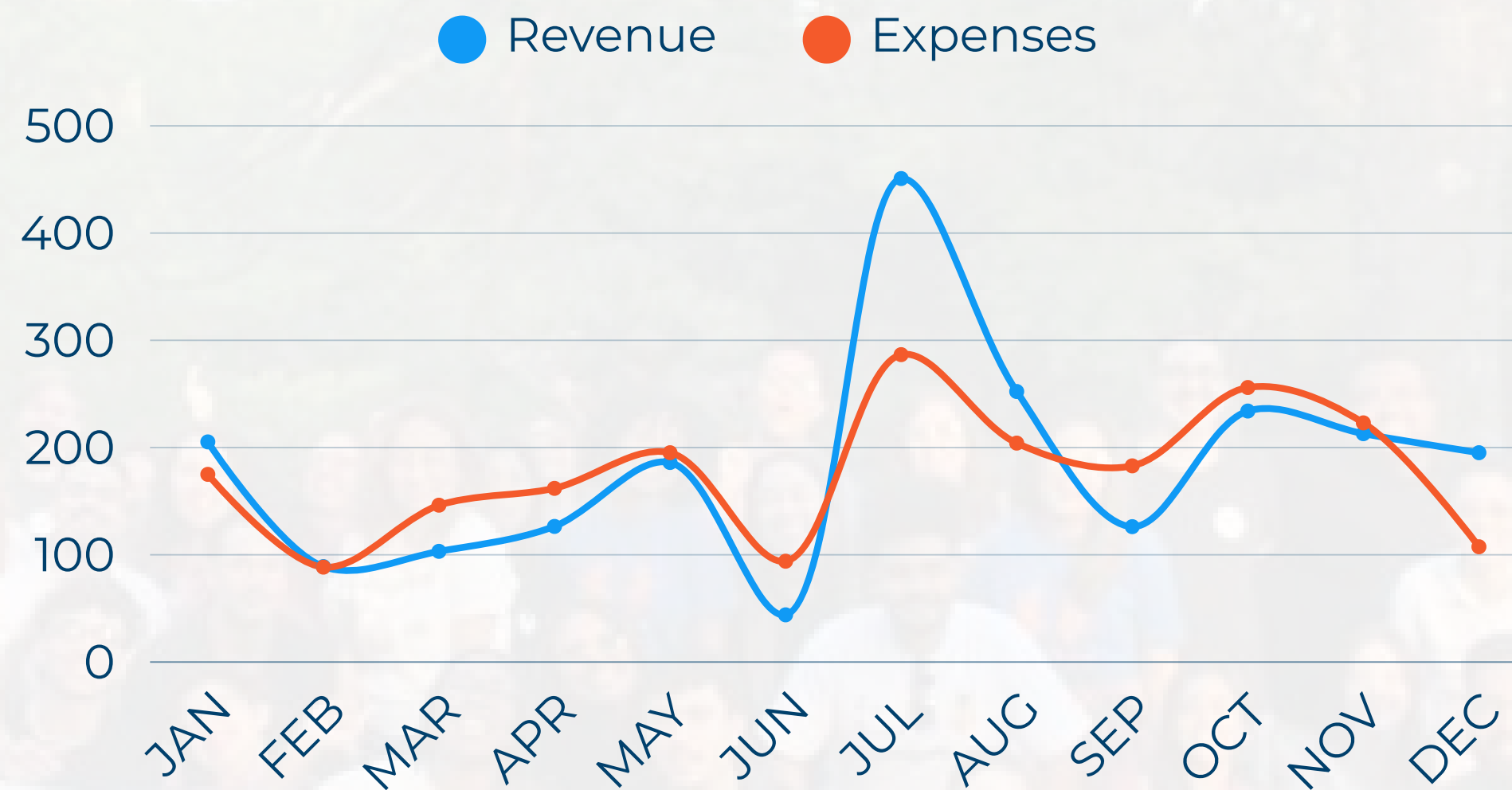

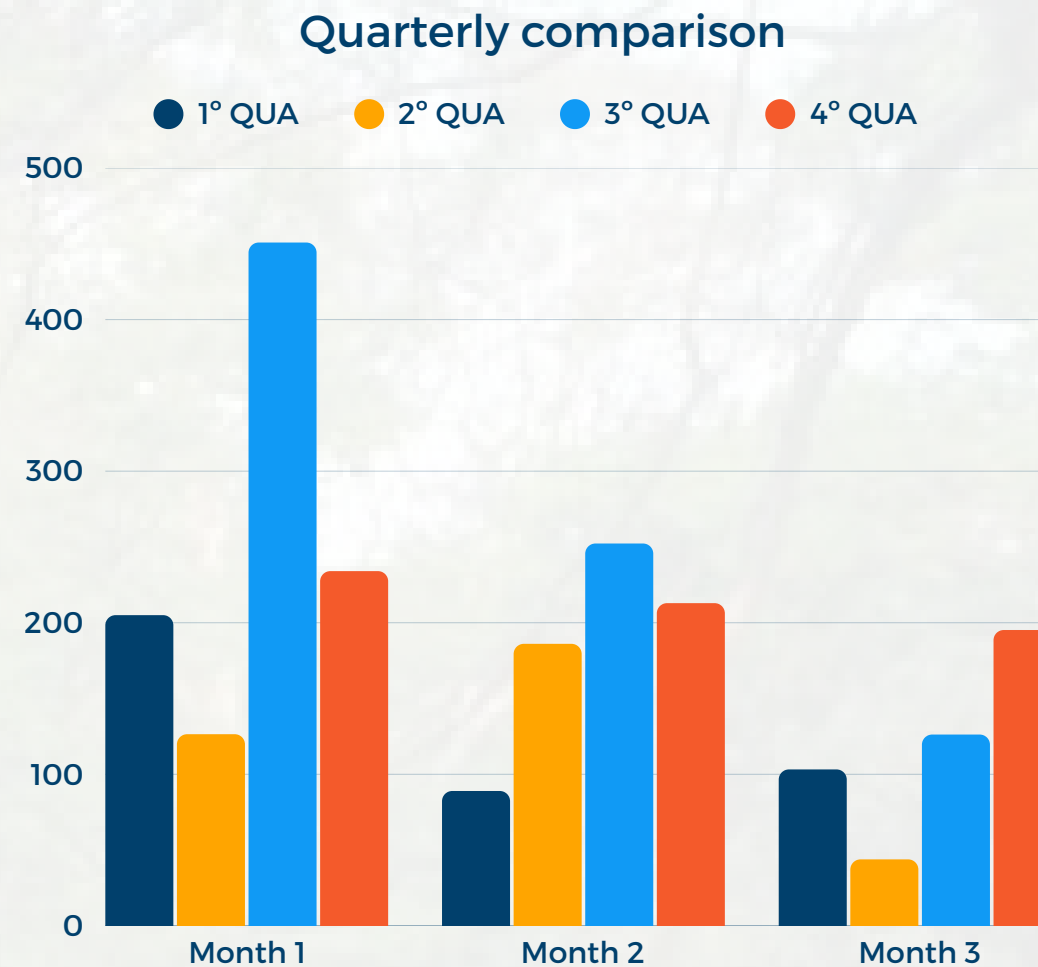
Revenue and expenses in 2025 (in thousands of BRL)

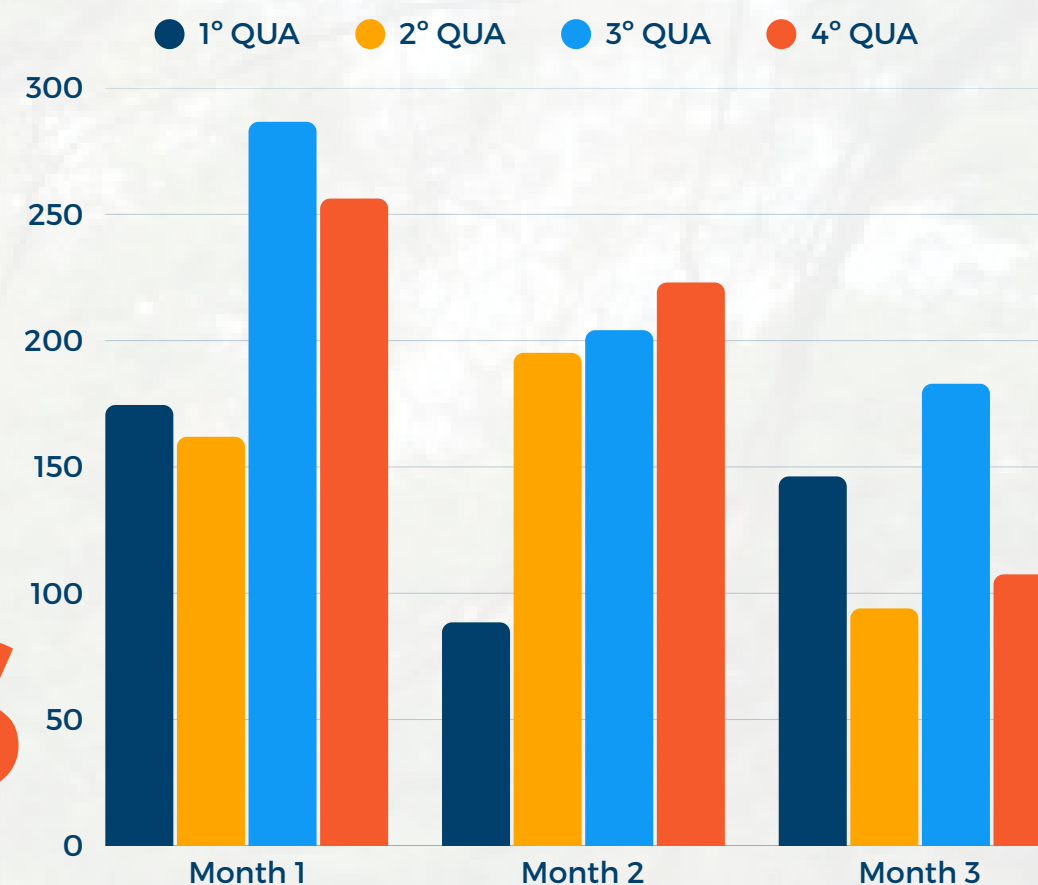

We constantly seek new solutions, but we never stop investing in the adaptation or improvement of our own sources of financial resources: the social fee from the selection process for our cohorts and the engagement campaigns in which students mobilize their networks to donate to the social initiative — a true community philanthropy movement where today's student helps bring tomorrow's student.
